Escrip and Amazon Smile: Kay is out of town so no report on the amount donated to date.

Homes Tour: One of the 6 homes initially selected for Homes Tour has fallen through; anticipate having another one selected by end of the month.

Donations: The first solicitation for donations to the AAUW Fund resulted in donations of \$3,360.

**Fund Scholarships and Grants Report:** Scholarship Application was emailed to the four high school career coordinators this week. The deadline for completion is April 1, and our review timeline will be to have decisions made by April 23. Need to identify two more reviewers. Janet said she'd help and Bev Lieberman also volunteered.

HEF is still in a state of flux. They now have no paid staff, as Cathy Wilson has moved on to CTE Foundation. Dana Grande, board president, is the contact, but she is very busy with her job. Rotary has decided not to fund a portion of the Mindstorms grant as previously requested. AAUW decided to fund the entire \$11,000 grant. The meeting was adjourned at 4:48 pm.
