9-3 Point Reyes Station

9-10 South Burma Trail Annadel State Park

South Burma Trail Loop is a 7.6 mile moderately trafficked loop trail located in the Trione-Annadale State Park in Santa Rosa. The elevation for this hike is 1,161 feet. It's a nice, moderate hike with lots of beautiful scenery, varied landscapes to enjoy, and a good amount of wild life. Bring poles, water, and lunch.

9-24 Jack London State Park

Elevation gain is 1817 feet. The trail is rated as moderate. Bring water, poles (the downhill on the Coon trail is steep) and lunch.
